PLACE: The three day camp will be held at the Warwick Showgrounds.

ARRIVAL: Horses & riders must be at the Showgrounds on **Friday 19th September** between 4-5 pm for inspection of both **Horse and Gear** and group allocation. This

includes boots, helmet, saddle & bridle. Parents meeting commences at 5pm. If you are unable to be there by 5 please contact Christine Bradfield.

ASSEMBLY: Riders must be assembled at the gate on the eastern side of the ring at **8.00am** on **Saturday 20st September** in their group and await further instructions. All riders to complete stable duty before saddling and assembling at their group area

MEALS: Morning Tea, Lunch and Afternoon Teas are provided for all riders. Meals are available for purchase during the camp for non riders.

DINNER: 5.30pm Sunday at the canteen. Come in for a social evening - Meal provided \$5/adult & non riders. Please bring a Salad or Sweets dish to share (BYO, plates, cutlery & drinks).

DUTIES: Parents are reminded that assistance will be required over the three days with morning & afternoon teas and lunches. Taking water around to the groups, assisting Instructors as well as helping your child saddling in the morning and putting their horse away in the afternoon.
Parents are requested to assist for at least one day or an additional \$50.00 will be charged plus membership if not a current member.

COST: The cost of the three days will be **\$130** per Warwick Pony Club Member.
\$150 per Non Warwick Pony Club Member.
An additional \$50 if parents are unable to assist for a minimum of one day.
The cost includes all instruction, morning, afternoon teas, lunches and Sunday night dinner. Horses will be fed 1 piece of hay 3 x daily.
You will need to provide all extra feed your horse normally receives.

SLEEP-IN: Richard Gibson and Ann-Maree Hamilton have offered to be supervisors for any riders wishing to camp at the showgrounds in the pavilion on Sunday night. Please indicate if you wish to stay and ensure you bring in bedding etc.

ENTRY FORMS: All entry forms and payment must be with the Secretary, Kellie Smith on or before **Friday 12th September. Any entry forms received after this date are could be rejected.**

EQUIPMENT

1. All children must have a properly fitting equestrian helmet (ASA3838 or better) with an effective chinstrap. The helmet must be worn whenever mounted – this includes instructors.
2. All participants riding boots must comply with Pony Club rules.
3. **All gear must be safe, correctly fitted and comply with Pony Club rules:**
 - A two or three buckle girth or a girth and surcingle.
The girth points, stirrup leathers & bars, & stitching should be regularly checked by the owner.
Bridles must have a bit in the horses mouth.
Reins must be joined. If reins are knotted, the buckle must be undone.
4. Each child should have a grooming kit including hoof pick, dandy brush, soft body brush and sponge. Suitable feed bin, a large open container. 10 litre buckets are not suitable for feed or water. Water container must be of 20 litre capacity or more – e.g. Large tuff tub. Stable fork/shovel/or manure bucket & gloves. Wheelbarrow is optional. Suitable footwear to be worn cleaning stables. *Stable rakes are available to borrow.*
5. No singlet tops to be worn. Shirts with collars. Please apply sunscreen before mounting.
6. Each child must have a Plate Bag (plates, cup, cutlery & tea towel). These will be left at the eating area outside the Canteen during Camp.

7. No Rowel Spurs, unless Campdrafting or Team Penning.
8. If sleeping over swag or bedding, pillow, PJs, toothbrush etc.

CAMP RULES

Please read through ALL rules with your child before the commencement of camp.

1. All children participating must be aged six (5) years or over.
2. All riders **MUST** be able to walk & trot UNAIDED.
3. Any child unable to bridle & saddle their horse must have a parent to assist.
4. Horses & riders must be at the Showgrounds & mounted between 4-5pm on Friday 19th for a gear check, this includes boots, helmet, saddle & bridle. Horses & gear deemed to be unsuitable will not be allowed. Riders will be allocated into groups. Parent meeting will be held at 5pm to allocate jobs.
5. No child is to be mounted until they have been instructed to do so.
6. During riding or instruction periods the Chief Instructor, or in her absence the Deputy Chief Instructor is to be in charge.
7. Any child who wishes to be excused from instruction or to leave the showgrounds must have the permission of the Chief Instructor or President.
8. All riders **MUST** wear helmet, riding boots and bridle when mounted.
9. Instructors and any other riding member must wear a helmet & riding boots when mounted.
Please ensure horses hooves are shod or neatly trimmed before commencement of Camp.
10. Children are expected to behave in an appropriate and safe manner at all times. In the event of misconduct a child may be suspended from riding or further participation.
11. All horses shall be returned to their stables before the lunch break & unsaddled.
12. No child is to be in the stable area unless permitted to do so.
13. No rider is to mount a horse in a stable or to ride a horse into a stable.
14. Any rider must have the same horse throughout the camp unless deemed unsound or unsuitable by the Chief Instructor. One rider, one horse for the duration of the camp.
15. Stables are to be cleaned daily and prior to departure on Saturday.
16. At all Pony Club events a mount may only have one rider. Schooling by a parent, other than lunging, is not permitted.
17. All participants in the camp are asked to ensure the clean up is completed before leaving Monday afternoon. This includes the stable to be cleaned out and assistance with packing away all equipment used throughout Camp. Please check with Committee before leaving.
